The revised formula statements referred to above are acceptable and have been included in our files. It is understood that formulas dated April 15, 1987 replace previously accepted formulas for these products.

Labeling submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following changes before releasing the products for shipment bearing amended labeling:
  - a. For EPA Registration No. 5967-111, reinstate the signal word "CAUTION" wherever a signal word appears on labeling. You have not provided a basis for a change to "WARNING." Replace "causes substantial . . . eye injury" with "causes eye irritation." Under Mixing Instructions for citrus, replace 3000 gallons with 1500 gallons. The 3000-gallon coverage appears excessive on a per acre basis.
  - b. For EPA Registration No. 5967-120, modify "causes substantial . . . eye injury" to read "causes eye irritation." Provide instructions for mixing with water including recommended volume for ground and air.
