THIS PRODUCT IS AN AGRICULTURAL PESTICIDE FOR APPLICATIONS BY GROUND OR AIR FOR THE BELOW INDICATED USES.

BEGIN APPLICATIONS AT FIRST SIGN OF INSECTS. REPEAT AS NECESSARY.

GRAPES: For Leafhoppers, Red Banded Leafrollers, Powdery Mildew—use 40 lbs. per acre. For Drosophila, Thrips—use 25 lbs. per acre.

For Powdery Mildew: Begin when new shoots are 6 inches long. Repeat before blossoms open and continue as necessary. Concord and other labrusca type grapes may be injured by sulfur.

Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.

PEACHES: For Mites, Oriental Fruit Moth, Powdery Mildew—use 40 lbs. per acre. For Drosophila—use 50 lbs. per acre. For Orange Tortrix—use 80 lbs. per acre. For Orange Tortrix and Oriental Fruit Moth apply at petal fall and every 10 to 14 days thereafter until control is achieved. For Powdery Mildew begin at first sign of disease and repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.
