The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

Before using this product, be sure the spray tank is clean and contains just enough water to cover the agitator shaft.

With the agitator in motion (120 R.P.M. or more) add the amount of spray oil required for a full tank. Pump the mixture through the overflow and back into the tank for a minute or two. The mixture should turn white, indicating good emulsification. Then fill the tank with water.

If an injector is used, first add 25 to 50 gallons of water to tank with engine running to provide good pressure. Then put injector suction tube into the measured amount of spray oil, opening injector valve to allow the oil to be sucked into the tank. Then fill the tank with water.

DO NOT USE THIS MATERIAL IF IT DOES NOT EMULSIFY.

DORMANT SOLUBLE OIL is a prepared emulsive dormant oil to be used on the crops appearing on this label when these are in the full dormant period.

BROWN APRICOT SCALE AND BLACK SCALE: Apricots, Almonds, Cherries, Peaches, Prunes, Nectarines and other deciduous fruits. Use 2½ to 3½ gals. per 100 gals. of spray.

BROWN ALMOND MITE EGGS, ITALIAN PEAR SCALE, SAN JOSE SCALE: Apricots, Almonds, Cherries, Peaches, Prunes, Nectarines and other deciduous fruits. Use 3½ to 4 gals. to 100 gals. of spray.

LEAFROLLER EGGS: Apples, Apricots, Pears, Prunes. Use 4 to 5 gals. per 100 gals. of spray.

Use 400 to 800 gallons of water per acre; for concentrate spray dosages, consult your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

TO OBTAIN BEST RESULTS WITH THIS PRODUCT, SPECIAL ATTENTION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE FOLLOWING:

Use efficient equipment of the proper type, avoid spraying during or immediately prior to hot or freezing weather, hot dry winds, rain or other unsuitable conditions, avoid overspraying or double-spraying.

Plants should be sprayed only when in vigorous condition and when their moisture condition is suitable. Consult with your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service for maximum dosage rate in your local area.
