**MIXING DIRECTIONS**

If there is any free oil on the surface, stir this into the emulsion. Measure out the proper amount of emulsion, and add it to the spray tank when the water is about the height of the agitator rod. The agitator should be in motion. If spreader is being used, add this when the tank is about two-thirds full.

Use efficient equipment of the proper type; avoid spraying during or immediately prior to freezing weather, rain or other unsuitable conditions; avoid over-spraying or double-spraying. Plants should be sprayed only when in vigorous condition and when the moisture condition is suitable.

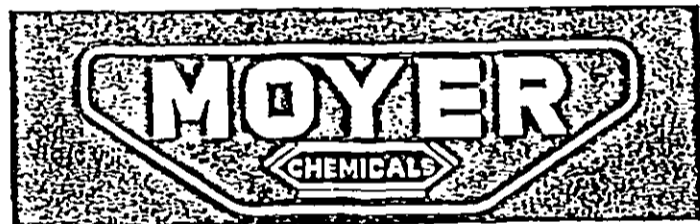

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near fire, or feed. Protect from freezing. Keep in shade. In case of spill or leak on floor or paved surface, soak up with sand, earth, or synthetic absorbent. Remove to chemical waste area and dispose of in accordance with State and local regulations.
