

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cleaning of Bar and Restaurant Dishes, Glassware, Etc.: Add 1/2 ounce of this product to 5 gallons of water. Dishes and glassware should air dry.

Cleaning of Dairy Utensils and Equipment

1. Thoroughly flush with cold or tepid water.
2. Wash with a solution of 1 ounce of this product to each 5 gallons of lukewarm water (90°F).
3. Drain, but do not rinse. Such use does not require a final potable water rinse as prescribed in Federal Food Additive Regulation 121.2547.
4. Before each milking, sanitize by rinsing with a solution of 1 ounce of this product to each 5 gallons of water.

Cleaning and Sanitizing Food Plant Equipment

1. Thoroughly flush with cold or tepid water.
2. Wash with a solution of 1 ounce of this product to each 5 gallons of lukewarm water (90°F).
3. Drain, but do not rinse. Such use does not require a final potable water rinse as prescribed in Federal Food Additive Regulation 121.2547.
4. Before reusing equipment, sanitize by rinsing with a solution of this product to each 5 gallons of water.

No Rinse Regulations

This product qualifies under Federal Regulation 121.2547, eliminating the need for a final potable water rinse at use dilutions providing up to 25 ppm of titratable iodine.

Milkstone Removal

Milkstone can be removed by brushing equipment with a solution of 3 to 4 ounces of this product per gallon of warm water followed by a clean water rinse. The formation of milkstone can be prevented by a daily use of this product.

NOTE:

Germicidal activity remains as long as the iodine color is visible in solution. When the color disappears, new solutions should be prepared.
