DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. For ordinary general purpose cleaning where total disinfection is not required use 1/3 ounce per gallon of warm water.
2. For heavy duty cleaning and complete disinfection use 2/3 ounce per gallon of water.

FOR EATING AND DRINKING UTENSIL SANITATION

1. Rinse to remove excess soil.
2. Immerse in solution of 1/3 oz. per gallon of water.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize by immersing utensils for 2 minutes in solution 1/3 ounce per gallon of water or spray rinsing with a solution of 2/3 ounce per gallon of water.
5. Rinse with potable water.
