DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dairies, Beverage, Food Processing Equipment — Farm Bulk Tanks, Pails, Strainers, Milking Machine Parts.

- A. Clean equipment immediately after use.
1. Rinse with clean water
 2. Wash with recommended Time Chemical product
 3. Rinse with clean water
 4. Air dry — protect from dust and dirt
- B. Sanitize immediately before re-use with TIME-SAVER CHLOR 16.
- Immersion or circulation** — use 1 ounce CHLOR 16 per 12 gallons of water (100 ppm).

TIME-SAVER CHLOR 16 fulfills the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade 'A' Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1965 Recommendations of the U. S. Public Health Service when tested by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizers — Official Method.

See Contact Time — It is not necessary to rinse after sanitizing with a 100 ppm available chlorine solution unless required by Local Health Authorities. Then rinse with clean, safe water. Any surfaces treated with concentrations in excess of 100 ppm available chlorine must be rinsed with potable water before reuse.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Product may cause irritation of skin, eyes or nose. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid breathing dust.

In case of contact flush with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention.
