DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This detergent/disinfectant has been designed specifically for use in homes, schools, food processing plants and other institutions where housekeeping is a major function.

DISINFECTION - To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces, such as walls, floors, table tops, add 2 ounces of product per gallon of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth or sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then rinse dry.

To disinfect walls, floors, table tops, add 2 ounces of product directly to the bowl of water, scrub the bowl completely using a scrub brush or clean mop, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand for 10 minutes and flush. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required and recommended. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned hard non-porous surfaces, such as floors, walls, table tops, add 2 ounces of this product per 5 gallons of water. Apply solution with a cloth, mop or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

SANITIZATION - To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, prepare 200 ppm active quaternary solution by adding 2 ounces of this product to 3 1/2 gallons of water. To sanitize mobile items (such as areas, chopping boards, counter tops), flood the area with 200 ppm solution of this product or apply with a cloth or sponge, making sure to wet all surfaces completely for at least 60 seconds. Remove and rinse thoroughly with POTABLE WATER. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. To sanitize mobile items (such as drinking glasses, eating utensils), immerse in 200 ppm solution of this product for at least 60 seconds making sure to immerse completely. Remove and rinse thoroughly with POTABLE WATER. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent.

This product when diluted at the rate of 2 ounces per gallon of water is an effective disinfectant against the organism *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and meets all requirements for hospital use. In addition, this product deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, toilet bowls and any other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

DISINFECTION - At 2 ounces per gallon dilution, this product exhibits effective disinfectant activity against the following:

VIRUCIDAL ACTIVITY - The product when used on environmental hard non-porous surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon of water exhibits effective virucidal activity against Influenza A2. As an representative of the common human herpes simplex virus, reagent of herpes simplex and human herpes simplex virus type 2, causative agents of upper respiratory infections, and as a representative of the polio virus (PVA 2004).

EFFECTIVITY TESTS HAVE DEMONSTRATED THAT THIS PRODUCT IS AN EFFECTIVE BACTERICIDE, FUNGICIDE, AND VIRUCIDE IN THE PRESENCE OF ORGANIC SOIL (5% BLOOD SERUM).

MOLD AND MILDEWSTAT - This product prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces.

SANITIZATION - When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items with active quaternaries to 200 ppm. At this level POTABLE WATER RINSE is required. This product is an effective sanitizer when diluted in water up to 250 ppm hardness (CaCO₃).

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
