DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. The disinfectant has been designed specifically for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants and other institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance.

DISINFECTION - To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops) add 2 ounces of product per gallon of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth, or sponge or mechanical sprayer as to wet thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

To disinfect table linens: Wash in hot, add 2 oz. of product directly to the final water. Soak the linen completely using a scrub brush or stiff mop, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand for 10 minutes and then wash. For heavily soiled areas a pre-cleaning step is required and recommended. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned, hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), add 2 ounces of this product per 5 gallons of water. Apply solution with a cloth, mop or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application at weekly intervals to when mold growth reappears.

SANITIZATION - To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, prepare 200 ppm active ingredient solution by adding 2 ounces of this product to 3 1/2 gallons of water. To sanitize table tops (such as tables, chopping blocks, counter tops), treat the area with 200 ppm solution of this product or apply with a cloth or sponge, making sure to wet all surfaces completely for at least 60 seconds. Rinse and reuse thoroughly with POTABLE WATER. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. To sanitize table tops (such as drinking glasses, eating utensils), immerse in 200 ppm solution of this product for at least 60 seconds making sure to immerse completely. Rinse and reuse thoroughly with POTABLE WATER. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more frequently as used in application.

This product when diluted at the rate of 2 ounces per gallon of water is an effective disinfectant against the organism *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and meets all requirements for hospital use. In addition, this product disinfects those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, toilet bowls and any other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

DISINFECTION - At 2 ounces per gallon dilution, this product exhibits effective disinfectant activity against the following:

VIRUCIDAL ACTIVITY - The product when used on uncoated non-porous hard surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon of water exhibits effective virucidal activity against influenza A2, Adenovirus 12, and the common flu virus. It is also active against agents of hepatitis and mononucleosis. Active against type 2 (causative agent of upper respiratory infections) and Vaccinia virus (representative of the pox virus group).

EFFICACY TESTS HAVE DEMONSTRATED THAT THIS PRODUCT IS AN EFFECTIVE BACTERICIDE, FUNGICIDE, AND VIRUCIDE IN THE PRESENCE OF ORGANIC SOIL (5% BLOOD SERUM)

MOLD AND MILDEWSTAT - This product prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces.

SANITIZATION - When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items, Time-Saver #531 provides 200 ppm. At this level POTABLE WATER RINSE is required. The product is an effective sanitizer when diluted in water up to 250 ppm hardness (CaCO₃).

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
