

This product is based on a highly active mixture of three Twin Chain quaternary ammonium compounds together with an effective fabric softener.

Soiled and contaminated fabrics such as diapers, hospital and institutional linen and athletic equipment is a major housekeeping problem not only in hospitals but in institutions, hotels, restaurants, and schools. Used as directed, this product imparts an effective residual bacteriostatic treatment together with softening to laundered items such as diapers, hospital and institutional linens and athletic apparel. For residual bacteriostatic activity, conditions of high relative humidity or wet contamination are required.

This product is designed for commercial and institutional laundry use by addition to the final rinse. Laundered fabric may also be treated and softened by soaking in a solution of this product. For recommended solution concentration, see "Use Directions".

This product is economical to use because it is concentrated. It should be handled with care.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To soften laundered fabrics and obtain residual bacteriostatic activity against gram negative and/or gram positive odor causing bacteria: Use 4.00 fl. oz. *8 tablespoons per 100 pounds of fabric (dry weight).

Dilute the appropriate amount of this product in one to two gallons of water; then add to the wash-wheel in the final rinse.

Retreat fabric after each washing.
