- g. Include the method(s) of application (e.g., sponge, mop, or spray) or "by immersion in the solution" such as to wet all surfaces thoroughly.
 - h. Include the statements "Thoroughly clean surface prior to addition of product," and "Prepare a fresh solution daily or when solution becomes visibly dirty."
 - i. On the right panel, expand and list the names of the vegetative bacteria against which the product has been tested and found to be effective.
 - j. On the right panel, include the statement "Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes" and "Wipe dry and/or let air dry."
 - k. Delete the claim for "sanitization" wherever it appears on the label, as previously requested in the company letter of October 21, 1986.
2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula agrees with the label and is acceptable.
 3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
