

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazard to Human and Domestic Animals

D A N G E R

Keep out of Reach of Children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.
