Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Formaldehyde gas is a known irritant to the eyes, nose, throat, and lungs. It is also a known carcinogen.

If formaldehyde gas is inhaled, remove the person to fresh air immediately. Wash the face and eyes with water. If necessary, seek medical attention. If symptoms persist, consult a physician.

If Formaldegen is taken internally, Practical Treatment: Give plenty of water or Peppermint Tea. Drink 2-3 liters of water daily. Induce vomiting by drinking 1-2 glasses of warm water. Do not induce vomiting if the person is unconscious or if the person has had a seizure.

In case of contact: Flush with plenty of water for several minutes.

Physical and Chemical Hazards

Formaldehyde gas is highly flammable in the presence of an open flame or flame source. It should be kept at all times to prevent this from happening.
