Directions for Use

- 1. Remove all animal life from area to be fumigated.
- 2. Clean room. Wash or wet ceilings, walls and floors. Formaldehyde gas is most effective when humidity of 60% and temperature of 60° F. or higher can be maintained.
- 3. Calculate number of cubic feet to be fumigated (length x width x height).
- 4. Set up FORMALDEGEN GENERATOR with heat turned off. Place required amount of FORMALDEGEN into Generator. Turn on heat to over 425° F. Leave room at once.
