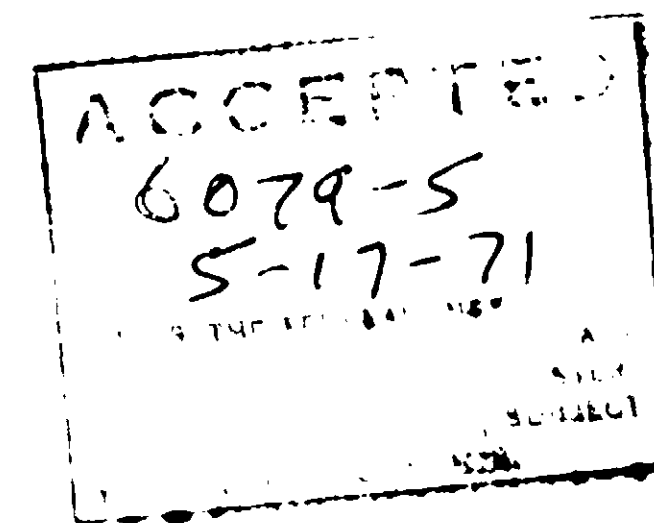


JIM-FROST COTTON DEFOLIANT

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Sodium Chlorate 18%

INERT INGREDIENTS: 82%

Total 100%

(Boron added as fire inhibitor)

CONDITIONS OF USE

For best results apply Jim-Frost only to mature plants when 50 to 60 per cent of the bolls are open. Bolls less than 35 days old may not mature after application of Jim-Frost. Plants having high moisture content will give best results. Wilted cotton is difficult to defoliate. Apply 2 to 3 weeks prior to picking on clear days with temperatures over 70° F. Do not apply under conditions of extreme heat during middle of day.

DIRECTIONS

Aircraft Application: Add Jim-Frost to partially filled tank and agitate thoroughly to insure uniform mixing. Spray to obtain uniform coverage. Make dilution with water so that 1½ to 2 gallons of Jim-Frost is applied per acre. Usually 4 to 7 gallons of diluted material will be required per acre.

Ground Application: Dilute as for Aircraft Application so as to apply 1½ to 2 gallons of Jim-Frost per acre. Usually 5 to 10 gallons of diluted solution will be required per acre.

WARNING: Keep out of reach of children!

Harmful if swallowed. If swallowed, induce vomiting by giving warm salt water—call a physician. Keep away from domestic animals. Wash spray equipment and clothing each day after using. Do not apply under conditions that will allow spray to drift on desirable vegetation. Do not graze Treated Areas or feed Seed or Gin waste to livestock. Avoid storage near Feed or Food Products.
