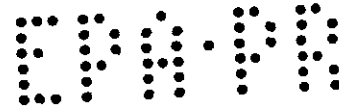

Mixing and Use Instructions

To reduce harmful germs, mildew, other molds and fungi during shampoo operations and to inhibit the growth of these harmful microorganisms.

Carpets all types including wool and pretested detergent-cleanable upholstery consistent with precautions concerning other additives in shampoo mixtures (example: Soil Lifter or Wool Soil Lifter).

Premix and dissolve granular shampoo additives (Soil Lifter or Wool Soil Lifter) in 1/2 to 3/4 of amount of mixture to be prepared (if these are required).

Premix MBI with FiberFresh Ultra Pro concentrate in separate container. For Preventive and Corrective Systems, add 1-2 oz. MBI to 2 oz. FiberFresh Ultra Pro concentrate per gallon mixture (8-16 ml and 16 ml per liter mixture).

For Salvage (Deep Soil Extraction Process and pre-spotting), add 1/4-1/2 oz. MBI to 1/4-1/2 oz. FiberFresh Ultra Pro concentrate per gallon mixture (2-4 ml each per liter mixture).

Add premix to shampoo mixture and bring to use dilution. Apply shampoo mixtures as usual rates for particular shampoo process being used.

NOTE: MBI is compatible with other shampoo additives: Quick Dri, Soil Lifter, Wool Soil Lifter, Grease Soil Lifter (For Grease Soil Lifter only, in case of extremely greasy or smoke laden carpet), Fuel Oil OdorGo and OdorGo.

Storage and Disposal

- Keep in a cool, dark area.
- Store in safe area to avoid breakage of glass container.
- Keep away from fire or open flame.
- In case of spill, dike area, take up material with absorbent and place in sealable container for proper disposal. For large spills, keep area well-ventilated and remove open flames or other possible sources of ignition.

Pesticide Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of empty and excess pesticide, spray mixture, or residue is a violation of Federal law. Container Disposal

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures.
