This submission is in response to your eight month product reregistration response to the Ortho-Benzyl-para-Chlorophenol RED. According to our records, all science reviews for this product mentioned above have been reviewed; however, this product contains two active ingredients, one of which is not eligible for reregistration at this time.

In order to comply with the labeling requirements as outlined in the Ortho-Benzyl-para-Chlorophenol Red, the following labeling changes must be made. Please note that additional label reviews will be necessary as the RED is issued for the other active ingredient.

A. The heading Statement of Practical Treatment must be changed to "First Aid" and the Statements must be revised to read as follows:

IF IN EYES:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advices.

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IF SWALLOWED:

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment.

IF INHALED:

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Note: The following information must be added in a separate paragraph at the ending of the First Aid statements.

"For additional information in case of emergency call toll free (telephone number).

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment."

B. As per the acute toxicity review, the spanish word "PELIGRO" must be added to the signal word section behind "DANGER".

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C. Revise the precautionary statements to read:

Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
Danger

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and chemical resistant footwear, goggles or face shield and chemical resistant gloves (such as barrier laminate, butyl, nitrile, or neoprene rubber, polyvinyl chloride or viton). A NIOSH respirator with an organic vapor (OV) cartridge or a canister with any N, R, P or HE prefilter.

D. As per the RED, the following text must be added:

“Follow manufacturer’s instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

E. As per the acute toxicity review and the RED, an “User Safety Recommendations” header and text must be added as follows:

“Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing”.

“Users must remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing”.

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E. The statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal" to currently appearing under Pesticide Disposal must be moved directly below the heading "Storage and Disposal". The storage text "Keep in cool dark area...for other possible sources of ignition." currently appearing on the label, must be preceded with the subheading "Pesticide Storage".

F. As per the RED, the following "Application restrictions" statements are required.


"Do not apply this product in a way that will contact other persons.
Only protected handlers may be in the area during application".

G. Delete the phrase "Only For Sale To, Use, and Storage by Service Persons".

Submit five (5) copies of draft labeling for our review.
