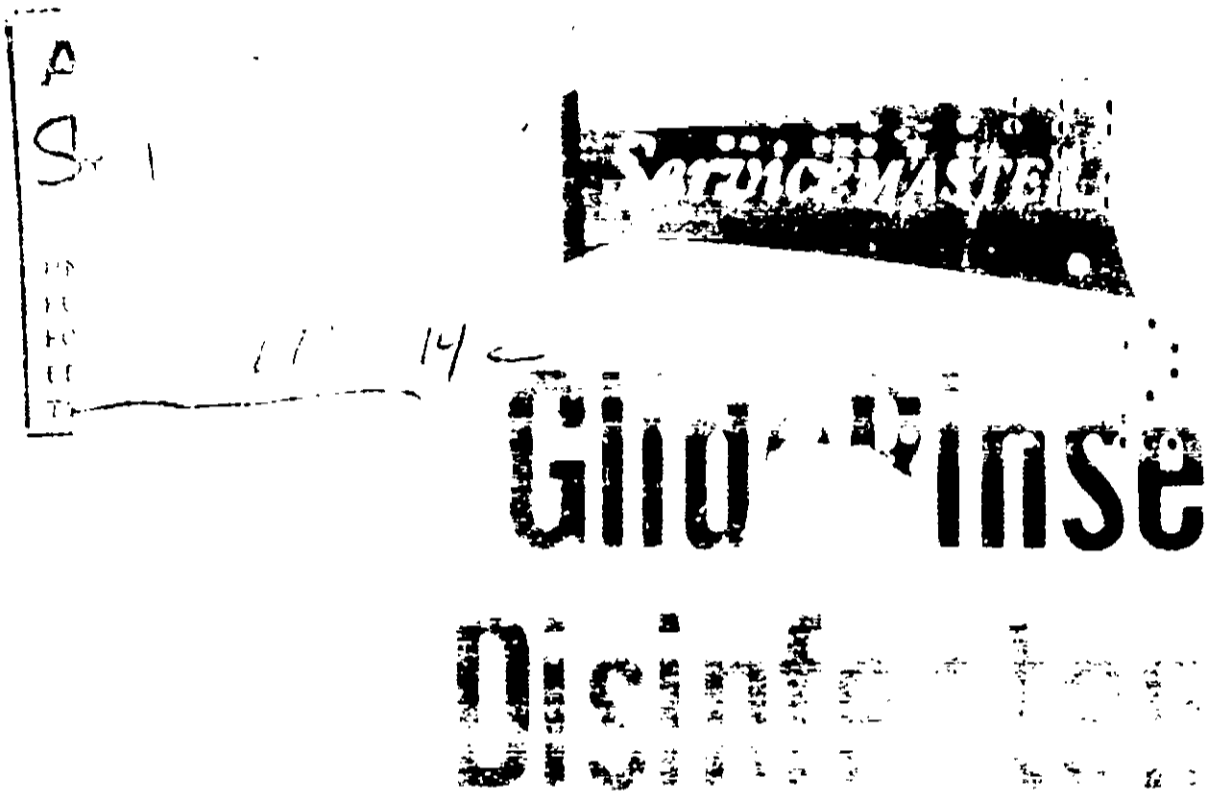

USE DIRECTIONS:

Use at 1 ounce per gallon of water. This product will be effective against Staphylococcus aureus and Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by AOAC use dilution confirmation test. Used at 2 ounces per gallon of water, this product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi. For best results apply GLIDERINSE DISINFECTANT by sponging, or spraying on previously cleaned surfaces in sufficient quantities to thoroughly moisten.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

If used to sanitize food equipment or other food contact items, limit the level to 200 ppm. quaternaries (3/4 ounces per 2 gallons of water). Apply use solution so as to thoroughly wet all surfaces. To properly sanitize such items as food handling counters, food storage bins and food mixing tanks all items must first be thoroughly cleaned with detergent. Rinse with potable water. Apply GLIDERINSE DISINFECTANT to the previously cleaned utensils with a mop or cloth or immerse utensils completely in GLIDERINSE DISINFECTANT. No potable rinse required.
