DANGER
Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling this product. Harsh if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contamination of food.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply GlideRinse III with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Sanitization in Hospitals, Nursing Homes and Other Health Care Institutions: For disinfecting floors, walls, countertops, bathing areas, linens, linens, tables, chairs, gowns, gowns and other hard non-porous surfaces.

Add 1.0 oz. of GlideRinse III per gallon of water (8 mL/l). Apply to previously cleaned hard surfaces. At this use level, GlideRinse III is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Salmonella enteritidis* in the presence of 5% blood serum when evaluated by the AOAC Use-Dilution test.

Sanitization in Institutions, Industry and Schools: Add 1/2 oz. of GlideRinse III per gallon of water (4 mL/l). At 0.5 oz. to 2.25 gallons of water (13.6 mL/5 l) use level, the fungicidal effectiveness of GlideRinse III in the presence of 5% blood serum against *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* has been shown utilizing the AOAC Fungicidal Test.

Storage and Disposal

- Keep in cool area.
- Store in a tight container.
- Keep container closed when not in use.
- In case of spill, shut off the material with absorbent and place in suitable container for proper disposal. Spill spray may be mopped up and the mop disinfected.
- Do not reuse container.
- Do not wash your face with it.

Pesticide Disposal

Do not attempt to reuse, feed, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray in can, or residue is a violation of Federal law. Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if there are no contraindications, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYCIANS: Probable repeated damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory arrest, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

GlideRinse III is a multi-use disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide, and detergent which is effective in the presence of organic soil. GlideRinse III is designed for use in hospitals, schools, and other institutions where hard surface disinfection can aid in controlling cross contamination.

Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and Other Hard Surfaces in Food Contact Locations: For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment, food utensils, dishes, silverware, glasses, sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other hard non-porous surfaces. No potable water rinse is required.

Wash and rinse all articles thoroughly. Then apply a solution of 1 oz. of GlideRinse III in 4 gallons of water (150 ppm active). Surfaces should remain wet for at least one minute followed by adequate draining and air drying. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. For mechanical application, use solution may not be reused for sanitizing applications.

Apply to sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by cloth or brush or mechanical spray device. No potable water rinse is required.

Dishes, silverware, glasses, cooking utensils and other similar size food processing equipment can be sanitized by immersion in a 1 oz./4 gallon solution of GlideRinse III. No potable water rinse is required.

At 1 oz./4 gallons GlideRinse III meets the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1978 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 800 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO₃ when evaluated by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Method against *Escherichia coli* and *Staphylococcus aureus*.
