The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to update the product labeling to include the wording "Residential Use", has been reviewed by the Agency and found to be acceptable provided that you make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. In the front panel "Statement of Practical Treatment" Section, add the sentence "Do not induce vomiting."

2. Delete the front panel statement "Only For Sale To, Use, And Storage By Service Personnel." in accordance with the Agency's requirements under FIFRA § 157 to eliminate the "serviceperson statement" from the labeling of all products not classified as "Restricted Use".

3. In the left panel "Precautionary Statements" Section, revise the sentence "Causes eye and skin irritation." to read "Causes eye damage and skin irritation.". After the sentence "Avoid contamination of food.", add the precautionary statement "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

4. On the left panel, either before or after the "Storage and Disposal" Section, add an Environmental Hazards Section with the following statements:

"Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant



5. Revise the right panel sanitization use heading to read "Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and Other Hard Non-Porous Surfaces in Food Contact Locations."

A stamped copy of the GLIDERINSE III product labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling this product. Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contamination of food.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply GlideRinse III with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surfaces must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection in Hospitals, Nursing Homes and Other Health Care Institutions.

For disinfecting floors, walls, countertops, bathing areas, lavatories, bedframes, tables, chairs, garbage pails and other hard non-porous surfaces.

Add 1.0 oz. GlideRinse III per gallon of water (8 mL). Apply to previously cleaned hard surfaces. At this use level, GlideRinse III is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Salmonella choleraesuis* in the presence of 5% blood serum when evaluated by the AOAC Use-Dilution test.

Disinfection in Institutions, Industry, Residential Areas, and Schools. Add ½ oz. of GlideRinse III per gallon of water (4 mL). At 0.5 oz. to 2.25 gallons of water (13.8 mL to 8.5 L) use level, the fungicidal effectiveness of GlideRinse III in the presence of 5% blood serum against *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* has been shown utilizing the AOAC Fungicidal Test.

Storage and Disposal

- Keep in cool area.
- Store in a safe area.
- Keep container closed when not in use.
- In case of spill, dilute area, take up the material with absorbent and place in sealable container for proper disposal. Small spills may be mopped up and the mop laundered.
- Do not reuse container.
- Do not stack over three pails high.

Pesticide Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

GlideRinse III is a multiuse disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide, and deodorant which is effective in the presence of organic soil. GlideRinse III is designed for use in hospitals, schools, and other institutions where hard surface disinfection can aid in controlling cross contamination.

Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and Other Hard Surfaces in Contact Locations.

For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment, food utensils, dishes, silverware, glasses, sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other hard non-porous surfaces.

Wash and rinse all articles thoroughly, then apply a solution of 1 oz. GlideRinse III in 4 gallons of water (150 ppm active). Surfaces should remain wet for at least one minute followed by adequate draining and air drying. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. For mechanical application, use solution may not be reused for sanitizing applications.

Apply to sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by cloth or brush or mechanical spray device.

Dishes, silverware, glasses, cooking utensils and other similar size food processing equipment can be sanitized by immersion in a 1 oz./4 gallon solution of GlideRinse III.

At 1 oz./4 gallons GlideRinse III fulfills the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1978 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 800 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO₃ when evaluated by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Method against *Escherichia coli* and *Staphylococcus aureus*.
