

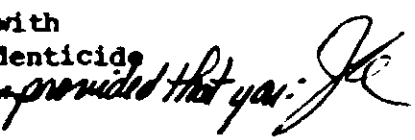

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is ~~not acceptable for the reasons given below~~ *provided that you:* 

1. Delete "Use Directions" and add "Directions For Use."
2. Add the misuse statement under "Directions For Use" as indicated on the enclosed edited label.
3. "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" should precede the signal word "Danger."
4. Add the "Storage and Disposal" statement according to the enclosed PR Notices 83-3 and 84-1.
5. Add "Precautionary Statements" per Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations.
6. Delete "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" from the right panel of your label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

USE-DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 1/2 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas - mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 3 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

USE-DIRECTIONS

FOR DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants and retail stores mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 1/2 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 3 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water and then disinfected. As treated hard contact surfaces and equipment must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent, and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

To disinfect toilet rooms, shower stalls, work areas and other areas, mop area with a solution containing 3 ounces per gallon of water.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 3 ounces of Pine Odor Disinfectant per gallon of water. These surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal matter or exudates should be then scrubbed with a detergent solution, then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 3 ounces per gallon of water before disinfection.

DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning or brush surfaces with a solution of 1 1/2 ounces of PINE ODOR DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. When used on hard surfaces such as floors, walls, and furniture, it may be repeated. Deodorize bathroom areas, garbage other areas where odorous odors occur. This product may be used in homes, schools, hospitals, nursing homes and restaurants. See left panel for use directions.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
