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DIRECTIONS: To control most weeds and grasses for extended periods on non-cropland areas such as industrial plant sites, parking lots, loading ramps and around storage buildings and the like apply 1.5 to 7 gallons per 1000 square feet of Weed Killer C after the most predominant weeds have emerged. 
