

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Use 2 ounces of DIASAN to each 100 pounds of dry fabrics, in the last operation of the washing process and run for at least 5 minutes. It can be used with or after the addition of the sour. Water level should be the height normally used for the souring operation. This should not exceed 30 gallons of free water per 100 lbs. of fabric. Finish the fabrics in the usual manner.

Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic detergent.

DIASAN is designed for the treatment of all fabrics where a durable anti-bacterial finish is desired.

DIASAN when used as directed will provide 312 parts per million of active ingredient based on the weight of the dry fabric.

DIASAN imparts a residual bacteriostatic activity to the laundered goods and renders them germ-resistant.

DIASAN leaves no odor or discoloration and will not affect the fabric.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid getting concentrate on skin or in eyes. In case of contact, wash thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food.
