DIRECTIONS

1. Add 1/2 oz. of this product to 10,000 gallons of water.
2. Mix thoroughly.
3. Pour into swimming pool.
4. Repeat every 2 weeks.
5. For best results, use in conjunction with a good swimming pool filter.
6. Do not use in hot tubs or spas.
7. Do not use in swimming pools with a salt water chlorinator.

DIRECTIONS

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one quart per 50,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

Pool-side surfaces: After cleaning surfaces, use one oz. to four gallons of water for sanitizing one oz. to two gallons of water for disinfecting.

Swim-Kleen algaecide is efficient, economical and stable in use dilution.

Swim-Kleen is compatible with all chemicals used in pool water and will not damage tile, concrete, metal, or plastics.
