

**STAIN-AID LL9**  
**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

**DIRECTION FOR USE**

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTANT WITH ITS LABELING

**STAIN-AID LL9** is a mildew and mold control cleaner that is effective against mildew and mold on painted, metal, wood, and plastic surfaces. It is also effective against household stains and is safe for use on most household surfaces.

**MILDEW AND MOLD CONTROL** Apply **STAIN-AID LL9** to mildew and mold on painted, metal, wood, and plastic surfaces. The product is effective against mildew and mold on painted, metal, wood, and plastic surfaces. It is also effective against household stains and is safe for use on most household surfaces.

**DISINFECTION** To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces, treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At 200 ppm, **STAIN-AID LL9** is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, and *Salmonella typhimurium*. Germicidal performance against the first three organisms has been confirmed by the *ATCC* 9695 Test.

Apply **STAIN-AID LL9** to walls, floors, and other hard, non-porous surfaces such as tubs, sinks, showers, and bedframes with a cloth, mop, or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when used solution becomes visibly dirty.

Rinse empty container with water before discarding.

**DANGER**

Keep out of reach of children. May cause severe eye irritation or eye damage. Causes skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 10 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, give milk, raw egg white, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink water. Call physician immediately.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Add the statements:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

to appear directly above the statement: Danger (back panel only).

- b. Revise the statement "May cause severe eye irritation or eye damage. Causes skin irritation," to read: "Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling."
- c. Revise the statement, "Rinse empty container with water before discarding," to read:

**DISPOSAL**

DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER.  
REFILL CONTAINER AND PUT IN TRASH COLLECTION.

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- d. The words, "ACTIVE INGREDIENT(S)" and "INERT INGREDIENT(S)," must be printed in type of the same size and be given equal prominence. The words "ACTIVE INGREDIENT(S)" and "INERT INGREDIENT(S)" must be aligned to the same margin.
  - e. The ingredient statement must appear on the front panel.
  - f. Place the word "Danger" to appear directly below the statement "Keep out of reach of children," (front panel only).
  - g. Revise the statement "See back panel for additional precautions," to read, "See back panel for additional precautionary statements."
  - h. Add the statement (back panel) "Statement of Practical Treatment" to appear directly above the statement "In case of contact...."
  - i. You are reminded that the EPA Establishment Number must appear in a suitable location on the label or on the immediate container. We recommend that you verify your EPA Establishment No. with your Regional EPA office located in New York, New York, for the appropriate EPA Establishment No. An application form is enclosed for your convenience.
  - j. Delete "Kills mildew" (front panel). This product will only inhibit the growth of mold and mildew.
  - k. Delete the claims: "Virucidal, fungicidal." Adequate use directions must be provided to retain these claims.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
