

Hold container 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with a slow sweeping motion. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Avoid overexposure. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness.

To apply to face, spray palm of hand and spread on face and neck. Do not spray directly on face. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. To apply to clothing, spray shirts, stockings and hosiery. For ticks and chiggers, also spray pant cuffs, socks and around openings in outer clothing. Do not use under clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water, wash treated clothing.

Safe to use on cotton or wool. Do not apply to synthetic fabrics other than nylon or polyester. May damage furniture finishes, plastics, linoleum, painted surfaces and waxed crystals.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS - HAZARDS TO HUMANS - BURNING: Harmful if swallowed. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated areas. Avoid contact with eyes and face. May cause eye injury.
