The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Delete the phrase "try Maximum Strength Muskol Insect Repellent products." No such products are currently registered.
2. Revise the heading "ACTIVE INGREDIENTS" to read "ACTIVE INGREDIENT." There is only one active ingredient in the product.
3. Add information indicating the length of time the product effectively "keeps mosquito away." The phrase "for hours" is vague and does not supply the user with sufficient information.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit three copies of final printed labeling, incorporating the comments listed above. When submitting revised labeling, please cite the specific study that supports the efficacy claim for repelling mosquitos, using the Master Record Identification Number (MRID) assigned by EPA if it is available.

In addition, a review of the file indicates that the confidential statement of formula (CSF) for this product is out of date. The last accepted GSF is dated February 8, 1985. Since that time, EPA has revised its policies for confidential statements of formula. You may wish to consult Pesticide Regulation Notice 91-2 and 40 CPR 158.175 for information on how to revise the CSF.
