To kill fleas and ticks on dogs and cats: Thoroughly mix at the rate of 1 fl. oz. per 1½ gallons of water. Thoroughly spray or dip animal. Repeat treatments may be used within 3 to 4 weeks.

To kill fleas and ticks in yards and kennels: Thoroughly mix at the rate of 2 fl. oz. per ½ gallon of water. Use one-half gallon of solution per 500 sq. feet of surface treated. Repeat treatment if necessary. 4 fl. oz. of Ectocide Dip will make enough mix to cover 1000 sq. feet.

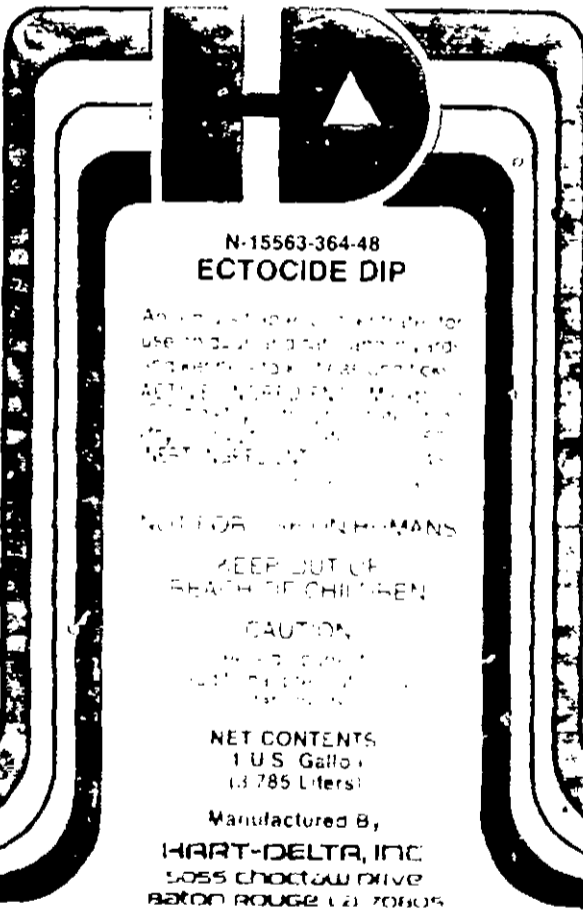
