## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill fleas and ticks on dogs and cats: Thoroughly mix at the rate of 1 fl.oz. per 15 gallons of water. (2 tablespoons per 15 gallons of water; 4 teaspoons per gallon of water.) Thoroughly spray or dip animal. Repeat treatment may be used on a weekly basis.

To kill fleas and ticks in yards and kennels: Thoroughly mix at the rate of 2 fl.oz. per  $\frac{1}{2}$  gallon of water. Use one-half gallon of solution per 500 sq.ft. of surface treated. Repeat treatment if necessary. 4 fl.oz. of Ectocide Dip will make enough mix to cover 1000 sq.ft.
