PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

HUMANS: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuffs.

ANIMALS: Do not apply to animals less than four weeks of age and nursing puppies. Malathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Consult a veterinarian at first sign of adverse reactions. Atropine is the antidote.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, and ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink large amounts of milk or water. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON. If patient experiences difficulty in breathing start mouth-to-mouth artificial respiration or administer oxygen. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine is antidotal only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

IF ON SKIN: Wash immediately with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. SEE A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill fleas and ticks on dogs and cats: Thoroughly mix at the rate of 1 fl.oz. per 1½ gallons of water. (2 tablespoons per 1½ gallons of water; 4 teaspoons per gallon of water.) Thoroughly spray or dip animal. Repeat treatment may be used on a weekly basis.

To kill fleas and ticks in yards and kennels: Thoroughly mix at the rate of 2 fl.oz. per ½ gallon of water. Use one-half gallon of solution per 500 sq.ft. of surface treated. Repeat treatment if necessary. 4 fl.oz. of Ectocide Dip will make enough mix to cover 1000 sq.ft.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool place out of reach of children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
