DIRECTIONS

Demodectic or Sarcoptic
Mange —

Thoroughly massage into and
around the infested areas. Re-
peat treatment every 6 to 7 days
as required. If condition is gen-
eralized, treat one-third to one-
half the body one day and finish
within the next one or two days.
Long-haired dogs should be clip-
ped, bathed and dried before
starting treatment. If no im-
provement is noted in 10 days,
consult a Veterinarian.

Otodectic Mange —

Apply several drops to the ear.
Repeat in 6 to 7 days as re-
quired. To prevent reinfestation,
strict sanitary measures should
be observed at all times such as
isolation, cleaning, and disinfect-
ing premises, especially beds
and kennels.
