The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

Statement of Practical Treatment should read as follows: 1.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give a lything by mouth tc an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash

affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of wa:er. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Under the heading Hazards to Humans add:

Harmful if swallowed. Keep away from eyes. inhalation and skin contact. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on humans.


While firmly holding pet, fill each ear canal one-half full with OTOCIDE.

While firmly holding pet, fill each ear canal one-half full with OTOCIDE, and massage base of ear to insure that insecticidal action of OTOCIDE penetrates ear wax. Repeat treatment every other day until condition is relieved. Improvement is usually noted after two applications.

DIAGNOSIS: Ear mites usually induce the formation of a dry, dark brown, waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of Dogs, Cats, and Rabbits. Ear Mites may be detected by placing some of the ear exudate on a dark surface and carefully watching for the movement of tiny white specs away from the exudate. Inflamed, watery, or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires the serives of a veterinarian.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool and dry place. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container with newspapers and place in trash collection.
