DIAGNOSIS

Ear mites usually induce the formation of a dry, dark brown waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of dogs, cats and rabbits. Ear mites may be detected by placing some of the ear exudate on a dark surface and carefully watching for the movement of tiny white specks away from the exudate. Inflamed, watery or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires the services of a veterinarian.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry location.

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
