The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act deleting the inert ingredient, Formaldehyde, adding new alternate preservatives, and revising the label is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Provide the chemical identity of the following ingredients. Include Material Safety Data Sheets and CAS numbers for each.
 - a. Quaternium - 15
 - b. DMDM Hydantoin
 - c. Kaco Yellow dye
 - d. Perfume Bouquet 485 W.S.

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

For the dye, the color index and CAS numbers of all components are required.

For the perfume, all chemical components must be identified by CAS numbers and percentage in the mixture.

2. Based on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated August 1, 1968 the product label ingredient statement percentages must be changed to:

N-Octyl bicycloheptane dicarboximide . . .	0.150
Piperonyl Butoxide, technical*	0.090
Pyrethrins	0.045

Alternately, you may wish to submit a revised CSF that agrees with the label.

3. Change the statement "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CONTROL FLEAS, TICKS, LICE ON DOGS, CATS, HORSES: Wet animal thoroughly with warm water and liberally apply shampoo, starting from the head and working to the tail. Work shampoo into hair coat to obtain a thick lather. Rinse thoroughly with warm water. For severe infestation, repeat application and allow lather to remain on animal for about 5 minutes prior to rinsing. For added protection, the eyes of the animal should be covered with a bland, ophthalmic ointment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
