

FLEA & TICK DIP
PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC
ANIMALS

CAUTION

HUMANS: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid contamination of food and food stuff.

ANIMALS: Do not apply to animals less than four weeks of age and nursing puppies. MitaShun is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Consult a veterinarian at first sign of adverse reaction. Atropine is the antidote.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
IF SWALLOWED: Drink large amounts of milk or water DO NOT induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. If patient experiences difficulty in breathing start mouth-to-mouth artificial respiration or administer oxygen. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine is antidotal only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present.
IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. SEE A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

IF ON SKIN: Wash immediately with soap and water.
