The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act removing the ingredient, Formaldehyde, and substituting other preservatives is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Change the statement "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
2. We received information from Felton International, Inc. regarding the perfume in your product. Additional information is needed however. We need to know the percentage for each chemical component in the perfume. You should have your supplier furnish this information as quickly as possible.

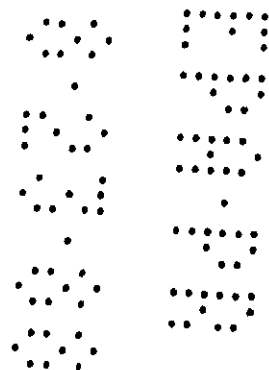

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CONTROL FLEAS, TICKS, LICE ON DOGS, CATS, HORSES: Dilute one (1) part FLEA SHEEN CONCENTRATE with three (3) parts water and mix to obtain a clear, uniform shampoo. One quart (32 fl. oz.) of CONCENTRATE when mixed with three (3) quarts of water will make one gallon of ready-to-use shampoo.

Wet animal thoroughly with warm water, and liberally apply shampoo, starting from the head and working to the tail. Work shampoo into haircoat to obtain a thick lather. Rinse thoroughly with warm water. For severe infestation, repeat application of shampoo, and allow lather to remain on animal for about five minutes before rinsing. For added protection, the eyes of the animal should be covered with a bland, ophthalmic ointment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
