DIRECTIONS

CATS AND DOGS: Remove cap and insert sprayer. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke, to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears, and chest until damp. With finger tips rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Spray only on back or on your fingertips and rub into coat. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 4 weeks of age.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh bedding for best results.

HORSES: To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies apply to face, legs, flanks, topline and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs by storage or disposal.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply AMBUSH to cotton as shown in the chart below, using sufficient spray TO OBTAIN FULL COVERAGE OF FOLIAGE. The higher rates of AMBUSH (0.15 to 0.2 lbs a/acre) may be required under conditions of heavy lepidopterous worm infestation. AMBUSH aids in the reduction of lepidopterous egg hatch by contact action. Timing and frequency of spraying should be based upon insect populations reaching local economic thresholds. Apply as required by scouting reports, usually at intervals of 5 to 7 days. For control of boll weevil spray on a 3 to 5 day schedule or as needed. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

REMARKS

Do not graze livestock in treated areas. Do not apply more than 12 pints per acre per season (3 lbs a/Acre). Do not plant any crop except cotton within 60 days after last application. Any crop may be planted if it is not harvested or grazed. *Only suppression can be expected when utilized on a 5-7 day schedule.
