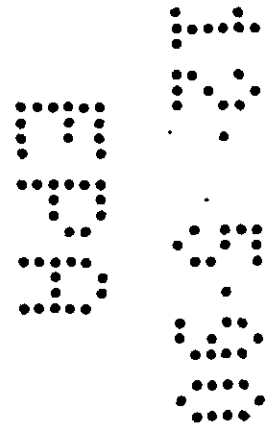

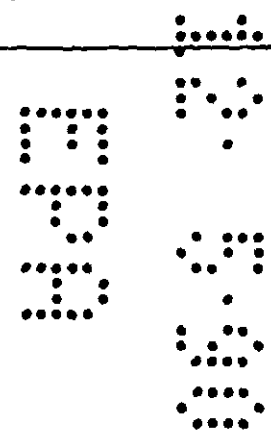

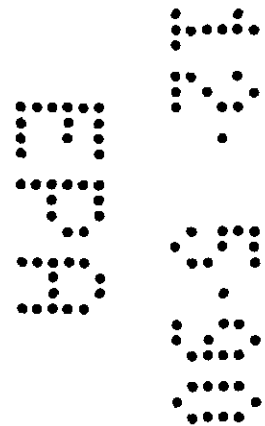

The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, NGK R-11, and increasing the amount of another active ingredient is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) Provide the chemical identity of the ingredient, Alpine #821 Perfume, and a Material Safety Data Sheet for this ingredient. All chemical components in this ingredient must be identified by Chemical Abstracts Number and percent in the mixture.
- 2.) Submit a complete description of the formulation process. Describe the equipment used, mixing time, temperature etc.
- 3.) Provide the analytical method used to analyze for the active ingredients.
- 4.) Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.
- 5) Provide information regarding the corrosion characteristics of this product. This information can be noted during the storage stability study.

- 6) Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). The following items need to be addressed.
  - a) The upper and lower limits are too wide.
  - b) In the CSF item 14h pyrethrin is listed as 0.2%, on the label it is listed as 0.15% and in the CSF item 13h it is listed as 0.79%. This is confusing.
  - c) The total weight in item 17 is 999.9 lbs rather than 1000 lbs.
- 7.) Change the statement "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
- 8.) Since your data matrix does not give a dielectrical breakdown voltage the statement "Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard" must appear on the label in the directions for use.
- 9.) Add the statement "Cover fish aquariums before using" to the label.
