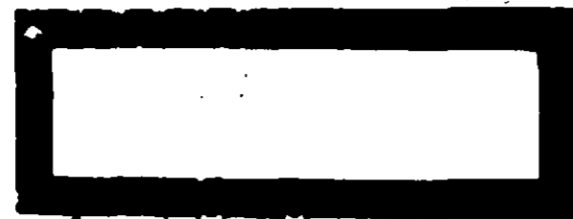


DIRECTIONS

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, GNATS: Close doors and windows. Pointing nozzle upward direct the spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Five to ten seconds application per 1,000 cubic feet space is usually sufficient. To prevent staining, hold nozzle at least 3 feet from fabrics. Keep room closed 15 minutes after each treatment.

COCKROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, FLEAS: Aim the spray toward floorings, all cracks, crevices, runways and places of refuge. Treat also ant trails, around doors and window facings. For silver fish treat book cases. Hit as many insects as possible with the spray. Heavy treatment is recommended, REPEATED until the infestation is under control. Continue at intervals of one to two weeks to prevent reinfestation. Treat sleeping quarters of animals in the same manner.

BED BUGS: Completely disassemble the bed. Hold nozzle close enough to coat lightly with oily residue, thoroughly treat all bed parts, springs, etc., especially around cracks and crevices. Treat the entire mattress carefully around folds or wrinkles, holding nozzle far enough away to prevent staining. Treat furniture, wall and floor crevices. Keep room closed for several hours. Repeat often as necessary.

MOTHS: Treat all suspected enclosures, arranging clothing and other articles so that the foggy spray can circulate freely and contact the contents. Direct the spray at wearing apparel, holding nozzle 3 feet away to prevent staining. Keep treated areas closed for an hour or more. Fairly heavy dosage is recommended, repeated monthly unless stored in moth-tight container. When treating wearing apparel, PARTICULAR ATTENTION should be paid to spraying the seams and folds of clothing.
