

**Q. A.** is a **DISINFECTANT & DEODORIZER**

Use in: **HOSPITALS, HOTELS, MOTELS, SCHOOLS, HOMES, REST HOMES, NURSING HOMES, RETIREMENT HOMES**

**GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS:** for disinfecting walls, floors, other similar hard surfaces.

1. **CLEANSE** — thoroughly wash with compatible synthetic detergent, soap or cleaner.
2. **RINSE** — after washing, thoroughly rinse in (with) plain water.
3. **DISINFECT** — make up solution as directed below\*; then apply with clean cloth, sponge or mop.

Allow at least ten (10) minutes contact time and/or immersion time.

No rinse required unless food contact surfaces are to be disinfected. Allow to air dry. Follow recommendations of Local Health Board.

**\*TO MAKE DISINFECTING SOLUTION**

**HOSPITALS:** Use 3½ Oz. **Q. A. Concentrated Solution** to 5 Gals. of water. Used as directed will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10.

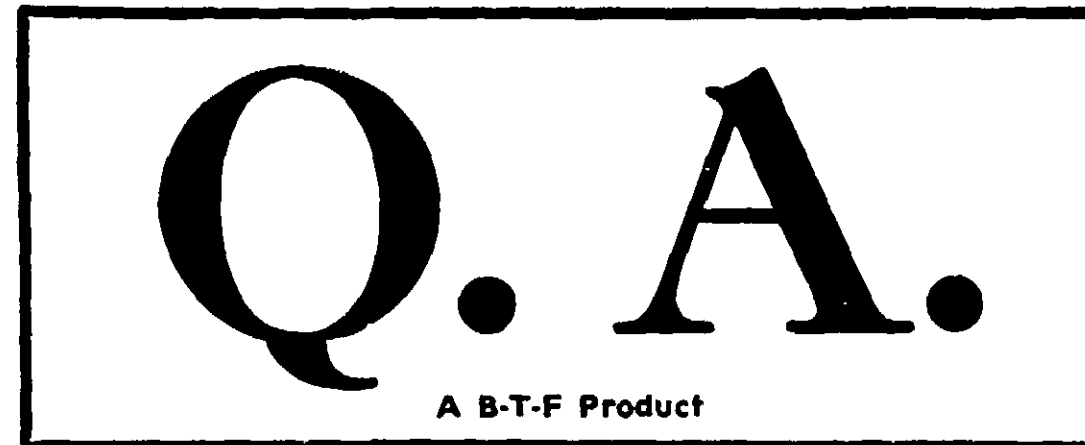
**HOTELS MOTELS SCHOOLS HOMES**

For broad spectrum disinfecting, use solution made with 3 Oz. **Q. A. Concentrated solution** to 5 Gals. water.

**To the user:** *If this product fails to satisfy, return unused portion to dealer and entire purchase price will be refunded.*

Keep container tightly capped. Do not allow to become contaminated. Avoid freezing. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

**Q. A.** Concentrated Solution is a **SANITIZER**

Use in: **PUBLIC EATING & DRINKING ESTABLISHMENTS, in DAIRIES, on FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT.**

**SANITIZER SOLUTION:** Use one Oz. **Q. A. Concentrated Solution** to 4 Gals. of water (195 ppm).

**USE DIRECTIONS**

**Restaurant & Bar Rinse** (Eating and Drinking Establishments)

1. Scrape and prewash whenever possible.
2. **WASH** — use a compatible synthetic detergent or soap.
3. **RINSE** — after washing, thoroughly rinse in clean water.
4. **SANITIZE** — immerse in sanitizing solution containing 1 Oz. **Q. A. Concentrated Solution** to 4 Gals. water (195 ppm). Contact health authorities if governing sanitary code calls for different ppm concentration. Immerse for 2 minutes or for contact time specified by sanitary code.
5. Put sanitized item(s) on rack or drainboard to dry.

**Dairies and Food Processing Equipment**

Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly, then apply sanitizing solution containing 1 Oz. **Q. A. Concentrated Solution** to 4 Gals. of water (195 ppm). No rinse required. Follow recommendations of Local Health Board.

**DANGER: Keep out of reach of children**

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Causes eye damage. Causes skin irritation. Protect skin and eyes when handling concentrate. In case of contact, wash immediately with plenty of water. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
