The labeling for the product referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended (FIFRA) is acceptable subject to the comments/conditions listed below.

**Conditions**

1. Move the statement "Providing 13.72% Available Chlorine" beneath the ingredient statement.
2. Revise the Ingredient Statement as follows:

Active Ingredient:

Sodium dichloro-s-triazinetrione dihydrate . . . .	25%
Other Ingredients: . . . . .	<u>75%</u>
Total:	100%

The proposed label classifies this registration as an acute toxicity category I product with the signal word "DANGER". The signal word for this product originally was "WARNING." Please, provide data/information to support this change in acute toxicity category from II to I.

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with a condition is enclosed. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

**FIRST AID**

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If wearing contact lens flush for 5 minutes, remove lens and continue to flush. Call a Poison Control Center or Physician for treatment advice.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or Physician for treatment advice.

(p.p.m. Av.Cl = parts per million of available chlorine.)  
100 ppm Av. Cl completely dissolve one (1) B-T-F® CHLOR-TAB® in 2 1/2 gallons of water. Stir well before using.

**TO SANITIZE GLASSES-DISHES-UTENSILS IN EATING & DRINKING PLACES**  
Wisconsin Five - Step Procedure

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with compatible chemical detergents in hot, warm or cold water ... T-D-C®, L-f-D®, TAB-DET®, L-f-D-TAB® or BLU-MAGIK®.
3. Rinse with plain ... potable water. Do not add any chemicals to this water.
4. Sanitize in solution of one (1) B-T-F® CHLOR-TAB® to 2 1/2 gal. of water. (100 p.p.m. Av. Cl) Immerse items for contact time specified by the governing sanitary code. Check with your Health Department as requirements vary.

**STORAGE and DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not expose to direct sunlight. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by disposal or storage.

**DISPOSAL:** WASTES: resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. CONTAINERS: Triple Rinse! Then dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures. Do not reuse empty container.

**NOTE:** Use a chlorine test kit to verify p.p.m. Make new solution daily or when p.p.m. falls below minimum. Check with your Health Department.

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
