## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

USE A COARSE SPRAY OR PAINT BRUSH FOR ALL APPLICATIONS.

# ROACHES, WATERBUGS, ANTS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS

Spray heavily in all cracks, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, areas around water pipes, etc. Use on other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as necessary, but it is recommended that applications be made at least once a month.

# - ACCESSIBLE FLOUR AND GRAIN BEETLES, WEEVILS, AND THEIR LARVAE

Spray liberally along the floor-wall junctions and in all cracks and crevices of flour storage rooms and other areas where infestations may occur. Do not apply in bins where loose flour or grain is stored.

# HOUSE FLY, FRUIT FLY, AND FLYING MOTH CONTROL IN BUILDINGS

Apply as a coarse residual spray to the screens, walls, and ceilings of the processing plant early in the season before canning or other processing begins. Repeat applications when plant is not in operation. Avoid contamination of foods and processing equipment. Outside areas such as unloading docks, garbage dumps, and other places where flies congregate should also be sprayed thoroughly.

## FLIES, PHORID FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, AND FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS

Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures, manure piles, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

#### CARPET BEETLES

Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks, or closets and infested areas of shelvings. Repeat as necessary.

## **BROWN DOG TICKS INDOORS**

Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets, and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Applications should be repeated as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this formulation.

## FLEAS, CHIGGERS, ANTS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS OUTDOORS

For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation, spray infested areas thoroughly. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur.
