The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Pyrethrins, Piperonyl butoxide (PBO), and MGK264 RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Use Restrictions:

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until sprays have dried. Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them after treatment and before use. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before use. When used in dairy barns or facilities, close milk bulk tank lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking. Except when applying to sewers or drains as instructed on this label, do not apply directly to sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems. Not for formulation into products with directions for use in mosquito abatement applications. Do not apply more than 1 time per day. Space sprays: Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area for at least 15 minutes, until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.

Food handling and processing facilities: Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. Prior to space spray applications, cover or remove food and cover food-processing surfaces or clean after treatment and before use. Direct application to food contact surfaces is prohibited.

SPACE SPRAY:

Moths, Fleas, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Fruit Flies, and Other Small Flying Insects: Close windows and doors and shut off ventilating systems. Apply MISTOCIDE® undiluted as a fog or mist upwards into the corners of the room. Mechanical fogging or

misting devices such as made by a DYNA-FOG® or FOGMASTER® are recommended. Use a fogger or vaporizer adjusted to deliver an aerosol spray (no droplets over 50 microns in diameter and 80% less than 30 microns). Close doors and windows during fogging and for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Apply at a rate of 1 ounce per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Direct fog or vapor toward the ceiling and upper corners of the area and behind obstructions. Close doors and windows during fogging and for at least 15 minutes after treatment.

SPOT, CRACK, OR CREVICE SPRAY: Roaches, waterbugs, ants, fleas, silverfish, spiders, crickets, scorpions, clover mites, cheese mites, earwigs, ants, and exposed stages of beetles, moths, and weevils.

Use MISTOCIDE® undiluted as a coarse spray dispensed through a low-pressure hand-sprayer intended for this use. Apply at the rate of 1 gallon to 1,000 square feet of spot, crack, and crevice treatment. Spray where insect activity is known, suspected or where they seek shelter. Direct spray into cracks and crevices along moldings, baseboards, window frames, door jams, and sills, and other similar protected insect harboring areas. Also, spray surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and areas around water pipes, and around animal sleeping quarters on baseboards, under bedding, cracks, and crevices. Only apply as a spot treatment to areas no greater than 3 feet by 3 feet per room. For use in drains leading only to sewage treatment systems to control roaches, apply sparingly around floor drains. For best control of wasps and hornets, apply directly to nests in the evening when the insects have returned to the nests.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near heat or open flame. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank for store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling if available or reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
