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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near heat or open flame.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:
Drums: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose in a landfill, or by other procedure approved by State and local authorities.
Glass Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.
Plastic Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerator, or as allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

PREPARATION OF MUSHROOM HOUSE

1. Close all windows, doors, and vents.
2. Take all precautions necessary to prevent people, pets, and poultry from entering the treated area.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

1. Calculate the amount of insecticide to be used based on the volume of the mushroom house.
2. Use 1.0 lb (2 fluid ounces) of Vapona per 1000 cubic feet of mushroom house.
3. Pour the insecticide into the fogging generator and mix with water into the fogging solution.
4. Adjust the metering valve on the fogging generator to the level of product produced by the fogging generator. The fogging generator should produce a fine mist of insecticide solution.
5. Walk through the mushroom house and fog the entire area. Do not aim the fogger directly at mushrooms or the growing beds.
6. Exit the mushroom house immediately after fogging is complete. Ventilate the mushroom house immediately after fogging.

Insecticides for the Food Industry

ANTIDOTES:
If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by sticking back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

If inhaled, wear mask, goggles, and gloves and wash exposed areas with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water. If on skin, wash with soap and water. If on clothing, wash with soap and water. If on food, wash with soap and water. If on food, wash with soap and water.

DANGER:
Wear a protective mask or respirator of a type PASSED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR PROTECTION OF WORKERS. WORKERS SHOULD NOT REOCCUPY TREATED AREAS UNTIL THEY HAVE BEEN COMPLETELY VENTILATED.

Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin or clothing with water for at least 15 minutes. If in eyes, get medical attention. Do not breathe fog. Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Do not eat, drink, or smoke during or immediately after use. Wash clothing separately from other laundry.
