PARATION OF TOBACCO WAREHOUSE

Close all windows, doors, and ventilators.

Take all precautions necessary to prevent unprotected persons from entering the teated area.

HOD OF APPLICATION

Calculate the area in cubic feet of the room to be treated.

Use one (1) fluid ounce of Summit TOBACCO WAREHOUSE FOG-GING INSECTICIDE PER 1500 cubic feet of space.

Pour the exact amount of insecticide needed for the calculated area into the insecticide tank of the thermal fog generator.

Adjust the metering valve or orifice size in the insecticide line to produce a dry fog. Never apply a wet fog. A flow rate of 8 oz. per minute is recommended. (For the DYNA-FOG "70", use the No. 4 setting from the closed position of the insecticide metering valve.)

Walk down the center aisle of the room, directing the fog from side to side

For best results, the warehouse should remain closed for at least 1¹2 hours after fogging. It should then be completely ventilated for at least 1 hour before re-entering.
