

Subject: Labeling Amendment Submitted 12/3/87  
 EPA Registration No. 6218-41

The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under 3(c)(7)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is amended, in acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. Replace the active ingredients portion of the ingredients statement, and the Environmental Hazards Statement with language specified in the Sumithrin Registration Standard.
2. Remove the phrase "General Classification" from the label.
3. Replace the storage statement with "Store in a cool, dry place, inaccessible to children. Keep container closed."
4. Replace the text of the If Ingested section of the Statement of Practical Treatment with "Do not induce vomiting due to the hazards of aspiration pneumonia. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately."

A copy of the stamped approved label is enclosed for your records.

#### GREENHOUSE USE

For infestations of whiteflies on Geranium, Chrysanthemum, Begonia, Aster, Calendula, Marigold, Dracena, Ficus, Schefflera.

**For Whiteflies and Aphids:** Apply SUMITHRIN\* GREENHOUSE SPRAY to the undersides of leaves. Use 1/2 to 1 teaspoon per gallon of water.

**For Spider Mites and Mealybugs:** Apply SUMITHRIN\* GREENHOUSE SPRAY to the undersides of leaves. Use 1/2 to 1 teaspoon per gallon of water.

Spray in late afternoon and repeat application weekly.

When fewer applications are needed, use 1/2 to 1 teaspoon of Summit SUMITHRIN\* GREENHOUSE SPRAY per gallon of water. Repeat as directed above.
