Dear Mr. Cohen,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- All First Aid statements are to be organized so that the most severe routes of exposure are listed first, and revise the First Aid Section as follows:

FIRST AID	
If swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. •Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. •Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Move person to fresh air. •If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. •Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If on skin or clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Take off contaminated clothing. •Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. •Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If in eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. •Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. •Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
Note to Physician: Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.



"Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR part II. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients' room. Do not return patients to room until Space Spray to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, and other flying insects has been applied. Apply with nozzle size. Direct spray upwards toward up per 1,000 cubic feet of space to be treated prior to re-entry. Sweep up and destroy Contact or Surface Spray to Kill Cockroaches, Droplets. Force spray into cracks and crevices around pipes and openings, along baseboards, etc. of surface to be treated. For area, appropriate application. In all cases contact area for control.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray on furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and under furniture and wherever these insects are. To Kill Bedbugs: Spray mattress, floor boards and wall cracks and crevices. To Kill Exposed Perms of Contaminated Food: Weevils: Find and destroy infested packages of the rained insects present. Please repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas: Remove and destroy animal infestations. Allow spray to dry and replace of animals with a registered flea control product. Space Spray to Kill Flying Insects: Outdoor use: viable fog or residue remains. Fog should be treated. Walk crosswind to cover area to be treated. Allow sufficient fogging time. 10 seconds.
