

Directions for Use

General Classification

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Summit SUMITHRIN GREENHOUSE AEROSOL kills adult whiteflies on contact when applied directly to the following ornamental foliage and flowering plants:
Roses, Chrysanthemums, Gardenias, Snapdragons, Viburnum, African Violets, Philodendron, Coleus, Begonia, Crassula, Carnations, Lillies, Ferns, Dahlias, Poinsettias, Geraniums, Fuchsia, Hibiscus, Petunias, Amaranths, Azaleas, Peperomia, Hydrangea, and Cactus.

For best results, apply during early evening when foliage is dry and temperatures are between 60 - 85° F. Shut off all exhaust fans and close all windows, ventilators, and doors. If greenhouse cannot be tightly closed, use higher spray dosage. Keep greenhouse closed at least 2-4 hours. Preferably overnight, following treatment. All human occupants and pets must be removed from the greenhouse prior to treatment. Occupants should not re-enter the building until it has been thoroughly ventilated.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Dosage: Apply 5-10 seconds per 100 square feet. For heavy infestations 10 seconds per 100 square feet should be used. Dosage is based on two feet high plants. Lower or higher dosage should be given based on the height of foliage.

Hold aerosol nozzle lower than foliage and angle spray upward so that the spray particles are driven under the plant leaves. Move aerosol in a fast sweeping motion to provide maximum coverage, maintaining a distance of 10-24 inches away from foliage.
