HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

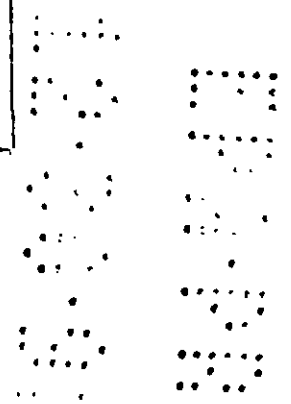
Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before smoking or eating. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result, consult a physician. Do not spray household pets or humans with this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Birds, especially waterfowl, feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present. Do not contaminate water by disposal. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues on blooming plants where they feed. Do not allow this pesticide to drift to blooming plants if bees are visiting the treated area. Do not apply this product to or allow it to drift to food crops or any desirable vegetation at any time.

Summit PERMACIDE DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For use indoors or outdoors. Spray infested surfaces only until wet.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, INDOORS

Spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and trails. Do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored. Discard infested food packages. Do not spray across top of stove or near pilot lights. Spray window and door frames where ants enter. Repeat as necessary. Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray. Take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. Use only in well ventilated areas. Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. Do not treat pets or plants with this product. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not apply this product in patient rooms, or in any room while occupied by the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms while in use. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not apply when other persons are in the immediate area. Do not use in conduits, motor housings or electrical switch boxes.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation.

Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Commercial non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or boiling). *bottling*

Commercial food/feed areas where the product cannot be used include areas for receiving, serving storage, (Dry, Cold, Frozen, Raw), packaging (cleaning, slicing, cooking, grinding), edible waste storage, enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups).

CARPET BEETLES, INDOORS

Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets, where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks and infested areas of shelving in closets. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS, INDOORS

Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Repeat as necessary. Bedding should be replaced in animal quarters after treatment. Do not treat animals with this product.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS, OUTDOORS

For use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate. Spray with wind to your back. Do not spray if wind is strong. If clothing becomes wet from spray during use, remove clothing after spraying, wash affected body areas thoroughly with soap and water and launder clothing before wearing again. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Do not apply to lawns or other desirable plants.

CHIGGERS, ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS AND CLOVER MITES, OUTDOORS

For treatment of localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation used for food or feed, spray infested areas. For ants, wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near heat or open flame.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:
