The best time to spray is early evening or early morning, The target pest and plant should be completely covered with spray solution to be effective.

Spray until leave are wet to the point of run-off.

#### NUISANCE PESTS IN OUTDOOR AREAS:

PESTS: Ants, Clover mites, Earwigs, Millipedes, Sow bugs (Pill bugs):

To help prevent infestations of buildings, treat the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet, where pests are active and may find entrance. Also, apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of building, including porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, garages, refuse dumps and other areas pests congregate or have been seen. Repeat treatment as needed to achieve effectiveness.

#### OTHER OUTDOOR AREAS:

PESTS: Ants, Crickets, Enrwigs, Fleas, DEER TICKS and Brown dog ticks:

For treatment of localized infestations of these insects treat areas where there are weeds, or overgrown vegetation. Spray infested areas thoroughly, For ANTS, thoroughly wet ant hills and runways, Repeat application as necessary as re-infestation occurs.

PESTS: Cluster flies, Flying moths, Gnats, House flies, and Mosquitoes:

PESTS; Caterpillars:

Applica hould be made when caterpillars are young and the tents are first led. For best results apply in the late afternoon or sevening, when caterpillars have returned to their tens. Wet tents on all sides. A few caterpillars may be seen escaping from the tent, showever they should die within several hours.

Do not spray animals.

People and pets should not be allowed in the treatment area until the spray has dried.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale, or other commercial seed production or research purposes.

#### HOME LAWNS

Bent, Bermuda, Bluegrass, Dichondra, Fescue, Irish Moss, Merion, St. Augustine Grasses.
